At our next meeting we are going to have New York style coney dogs and build your own sundae. Please bring your favorite dish.

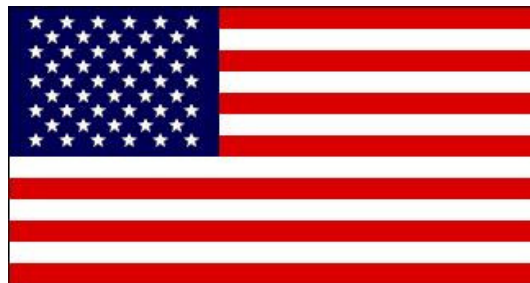

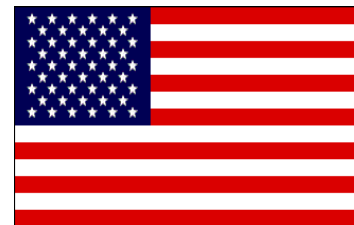
