Summary of Officer Duties

Faithful Navigator - presides at all meetings of the Assembly. In parliamentary and other decisions as presiding officer the FN will be strictly just and impartial; eliminate at once any attempt on the part of members for the control of the Assembly and its domination for selfish purposes. Insist at all times that the Assembly must be fraternal and patriotic in fact as well as in name. Enforce the laws strictly, but not harshly, keeping in mind at all times that the good of the Order of the Knights of Columbus comes before any individual member. With patriotism, charity, unity and fraternity practiced in our Order you need not fear for success.

Faithful Captain - In the absence of the Faithful Navigator will assume his duties, will assure a good attendance at meetings and other functions of the Assembly and to take direct charge of all activities social and otherwise under that portion of the order of business known as the Good of the Order.

Faithful Pilot - The duties correspond with the duties of the Warden of a Council, and require careful and diligent performance. The Faithful Pilot is responsible for the arrangement of the Assembly chamber, have charge of all prosperities except moneys, accounts and record books of the officers but including ceremonials. Direct and be responsible for the activities of the Inner and Outer Sentinels. Acquire and maintain a thorough knowledge of the policies, procedures and protocols governing the National Flag.

Faithful Comptroller - shall Maintain Records. Keep roll of member information, collect and receive all moneys due the Assembly, keep account of charges and receipts of each member, provided member and account reports and perform all other acts required by laws of the fourth degree, the order and the rules of the board os directors.

Faithful Scribe - will be expected to attend all meetings of the Assembly and truthfully and accurately record and report the proceedings of the meetings and conduct correspondence of the Assembly and perform such other duties as the Assembly of the order may direct.

Faithful Purser - shall be the custodian of all funds of the Assembly obtained from any source. At each meeting receive moneys from the Faithful Comptroller and provide written receipts, pay all orders drawn on him, keep separate accounts of moneys and provide his books for annual audit.

Sentinels - The Faithful Inner and Outer Sentinels are entrusted with the responsibility of seeing that all in attendance at the Assembly function are position of both the 3rd and 4th degree travel card and report so to the Pilot. They shall perform such other duties as may be imposed upon them by the Faithful Pilot.

Faithful Admiral - Preside at all meetings of the Assembly in the absence of the Faithful Navigator and Faithful Captain. In the absence of the Faithful Friar, perform his duties at Assembly meetings and perform all other duties assigned to home by the Faithful Navigator.

Trustees - Trustees shall be responsible to watch and guard the finances of this Assembly and to see that they are properly applied. Trustees shall audit the reports of the financial officers and periodically report to the members and to the Master of your District. keep this Assembly in a sound and healthy financial condition.
