Business Meeting Minutes - July 18, 2012

Meeting commenced at exactly 7:27PM by F.N. Gordon Pickett. (He is on target to continue his predecessor's efforts in beginning all meetings on time or early!)

Reading of minutes: The minutes were motioned to be approved as entered by Charlie Higdon, seconded by Gene Ebert, voted on and passed.

District Master's Report: No report.

Faithful Friar's Report: No report.

Bills and Communications: Bills were motioned by Gene Ebert and seconded by Wayne Patterson to be sent on for review and payment to the Trustees. This was voted on, approved, and completed.

Faithful Navigator Sir Knight Gordon Pickett had no communications at this time.

Faithful Navigator's Report: Faithful Navigator Gordon Pickett then continued with the Navigator's report:

Our Faithful Navigator began with a reminder that new business would include our discussion on our donation amount and area for the Vets.

His next point asked for the preparation of our audit which is due in by 7/31. Our Comptroller and Purser responded with news of it's completion as review ready with the Trustees ...which would hopefully be completed after the meeting. Way to go, guys.

S.K. Pickett then mentioned that the "Know Your Knight" offering in our monthly newsletter would continue and that Past Faithful Navigator C.W. Higdon would be in charge. Please respond with information as requested.

He concluded with the request for attendance for our Installation of Officers at St. Joe's Cathedral following the 5:30 Mass on July 21st.

Faithful Captain's Report: Faithful Captain SK Steve Dodaro then informed all of the attendance and take from tonight's meal where 29 attended an ice cream social and a profit was returned from money collected. Next months menu includes pulled pork and Steve will attempt to send out a reminder on what to bring preceding the meeting.

Faithful Comptroller's Report: Faithful Comptroller SK Terry Reine then reported that no report was necessary at this time.

Report of the 3rd Degree: St Pius mentioned that the Historical Society was having a Civil War Re-enactment with the first Black Regiment being highlighted on July 20. It was mentioned the Fried Green Tomato Truck would be at the Pataskala Street Fair beginning August 14.

Seton mentioned a First Degree scheduled for 7/25. As of this typing it was cancelled due to number of attendees and cleaning work being scheduled at the church. We'll shoot for August.

New Business: It was motioned by C.W. Higdon to donate our Veterans funds to be used for their Coffee fund ...which has been done in the past. This was seconded by Wayne Patterson, discussed briefly, voted upon and passed.
